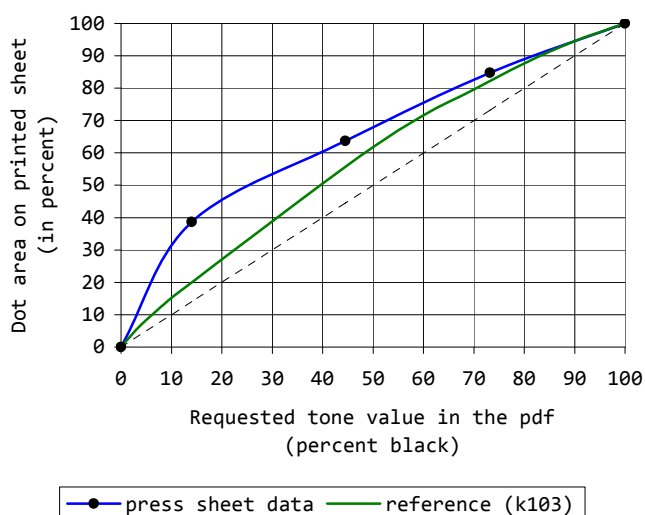
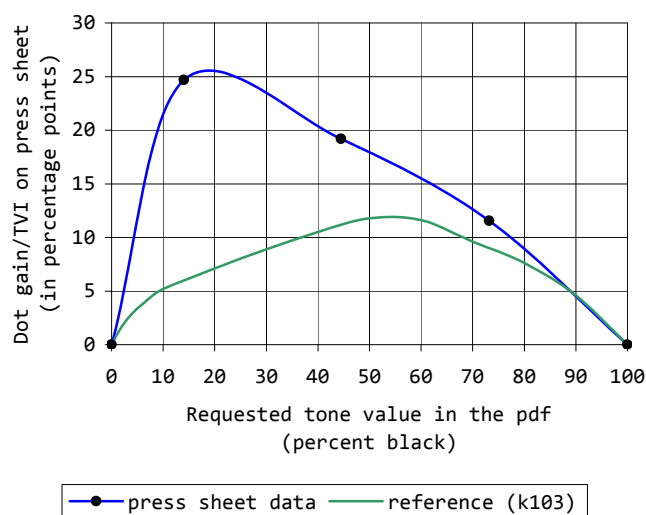


FIGURE 2 United Kingdom census, 2001: percentage of national population by ethnic group. The white population is subdivided into British, Irish, and "other white." The mixed population
