

WRONG VIEWER OR WRONG SETTINGS!

If you use Adobe Acrobat or Adobe Reader (version 9 or higher), there must be a setting wrong. You can change this quite easily:

Edit (Win) or Acrobat/Reader (Mac) > Preferences > Page Display and set 'Use overprint preview' to 'Always'.

Other PDF viewers are NOT reliable in a printing workflow. Close the program and open the PDF in Adobe Acrobat or Adobe Reader. You can download the latest version of the free Adobe Reader here: <http://get.adobe.com/reader/>
