Obviously you didn't read the PDF entitled *Bearer Collision*.

Bearer to bearer pressure must be greater than the counter forces exerted by Plate+ packing over/under bearer height this applies to the blanket parameters, these variables can and are changed within certain tolerances

Bearer Pre-load– this setting is done by the Press manufacturer, and not within the normal press adjustments done by the Pressman.
