



Notes on printing practice



A sheet board above the feeder

Mr L. H., Landskrona, Sweden, writes:

If sheets have to be removed from the feed table there is no suitable place to put them. In our works we have constructed and easily fitted sheet board consisting of a frame with expanded metal top, and with

the legs so designed that the board is easily removed.

We have seen similar devices in a printing works on Roland machines and the following two illustrations show how these practical sheet boards are fitted and designed.
